SUMMARY AND LEARNING OUTCOMES:

This course aims to equip the student with the basic and fundamental knowledge of the entire development of the new Greek literature, from the Generation of the 1920s to the 1960s/70s (the end of modernism). This period covers a variety of literary and artistic developments, not only in Greece, but throughout Europe. The movement of modernism, surrealism and symbolism is treated in a special way. With the recognition of these literary trends and genres, the student will deepen his knowledge of their developments in literature, in combination with the representatives of each of them in Greece and their main works.

General objectives:

- ✓ Knowledge of the developments of new Greek literature throughout the IX-XX centuries;
- ✓ the continuation of the development of modernism;

- the generation of the 1930s;
- the emergence of surrealism and its main representatives in poetry and prose;
- ✓ post-war literature (1945) and the main representatives in poetry and prose.

Specific objectives:

- ✓ Students will be equipped with in-depth knowledge of the most essential literary developments of the new Greek literature in the period of the century. IX to XX, as well as with its representatives;
- ✓ They will benefit from more extensive knowledge in terms of literature, history, philology and language.
