We invite all researchers, lecturers, doctoral students, post-graduate students, translators and interested parties to participate in the International Scientific Symposium on the theme: "

DOSTOYEVSKY AND HIS GENIUS", which will be organized on June 6, 2023.

This symposium is held in honor of the bicentenary of the birth of the great Russian writer FM Dostoyevsky, whose work has come complete in the Albanian language, as well as taking into account the writer's extraordinary contribution to Russian and world literature, and the appreciation of UNESCO, as one of the most quoted and translated Russian authors in the world, whose legacy is studied in schools, universities, as well as by scientists of various profiles. This international scientific symposium is dedicated to the perception of the work of the great writer in world culture. The importance of this event is appreciated due to the fact that the work of the great writer reflects not only the past of humanity, but also its future. Therefore, by studying Dostoevsky today, one can understand the prospects for the development of humanity in the future. In this symposium, a wider participation of researchers both inside the country and outside it is considered, considering Dostoevsky as a complexity in the linguistic, literary, philosophical, cultural and not only. The translations of his work in different languages and the finding of his complete work in the Albanian language make possible interesting studies in the field of translation.

Subtopics of the conference:

- The legacy of FM Dostoevsky in world and Russian culture and history;
- Dostoevsky in religious and philosophical thought;
- Dostoevsky's influence on Russian modernism;
- Dostoevsky and European philosophy of the 19th-20th centuries;
- Poetics of FM Dostoevsky's prose (narration, genre, style);
- Dostoevsky in Russian religious and philosophical thought of the Silver Age;
- Unknown pages of the life and work of FM Dostoevsky;
- Dostoevsky in the educational paradigm;
- Dostoevsky and Russian linguistic consciousness;
- "Diary of a writer" as a literary and philosophical phenomenon;
- FM Dostoevsky and fine arts. Writer as art critic;
- Dostoevsky and world literature;





- Dostoevsky and Russian literature;
- Dostoevsky in Albania;
- Dostoevsky in the fate of people of the 20th century;
- Features of Dostoevsky's language and style;
- Dostoevsky in translations in different languages;
- Dostoevsky through the eyes of young people (discussion platform for young people).

This symposium will be held in Tirana on June 6, 2023 and the papers/abstracts will be published in Tirana, Albania.

The reference languages will be Albanian, Russian and English.

You are also welcome for virtual participation. Physical attendance is not necessary for those presenting poster and/or video conference presentations.

The scientific activity is organized by the Branch of Russian Language, Department of Slavic and Balkan Languages, Faculty of Foreign Languages, University of Tirana (Albania), with the participation and support of colleagues from the state university M.V. Lomonosov, Moscow.

- You will be notified about the acceptance of the abstract on April 17, 2023.

The abstract should include:

- The title of the message (emphasized, centered, in "Times New Roman", size 14);
- The name of the author (his scientific title, the institution where he is employed, the "e-mail" address, size 11);





- Text (font used: "TimesNew Roman", size 12, "margin" normal, space "single"
- Keywords (max 5, size 11, italics).
