General objectives:

This compulsory course and presents the story of Spanish literature from the late nineteenth century to the present day. It is necessary for the student to have communication skills in Spanish at level C1, training in the subject of Literature Theory and in the subject of Literature 1 and 2. This subject is closely related to the subjects of Spanish civilization and culture.

This course aims to provide the student with the basic knowledge of the development of Spanish literature in twentieth century to the present day. This is a period of literary development that combines Spanish literature with that European and Hispanic, while recognizing the peaks that marked the history of world literature.

The student knows the literary currents that were delivered in these centuries in Spain, and gains general knowledge regarding the history of literature and in particular modern and contemporary literature as part of the culture of the country and the historical, social conditions in which they developed.

- Know the main movements, authors and literary works of Spanish literature from 20th century to the present day.
- Acquire a general knowledge of contemporary literature.
- Improve their critical exploration of representative literary texts, primarily of a narrative and lyrical nature.
- Improve their argumentative capacity through the search, preparation and representation in the classroom of different books.
- The course increase the communicative competence of the students through the reading, analysis and exposition of different arguments.

- Place movements, currents, authors and books chronologically.
- Manage the fundamental bibliography and documentation on the literature under study.
