Accepted papers for presentation at the congress will be published in electronic format.

Each abstract should include the following:

- Title of the abstract (emphasized, centered, in "Times New Roman," size 14);
- Authors' names, academic titles, affiliations, and e-mail addresses (size 12);
- The main text (font: "Times New Roman," size 12, normal margins, single spacing);
- Keywords (maximum of 5, size 12, in italics).
