COURSE SUMMARY AND STUDENT LEARNING OUTCOMES

General Course Objectives: This course aims to prepare students to communicate at an advanced level in Russian and to gain a deep understanding of Russian culture and history. It develops students' skills to communicate effectively in various situations, including conversations, writing different types of texts, and interpretation. The student should be able to progress from a lower level to a higher proficiency level in Russian language mastery.

Specific Course Objectives:

- 1. To enable students to use advanced Russian in both spoken and written forms, adhering to lexical, grammatical, and stylistic norms.
- 2. To develop the ability to analyze, interpret, and discuss literary and cultural texts in Russian, including their historical and cultural contexts.

Expected Learning Outcomes:

- 1. The course aims at practical mastery of the Russian language, equipping students with basic communicative skills (reading, listening, speaking, writing) on various familiar topics, based on acquired lexical and grammatical materials.

They will develop the skill to analyze and interpret important texts in Russian, including literary works by Russian authors.
