COURSE SUMMARY AND LEARNING OUTCOMES

General Course Objectives: Students should have basic knowledge of the Turkish language. The Turkish language as a second language is taught in two modules, placed in the first and second semesters. Students will work using an advanced level method, at the B2 level of the chosen teaching method. They will learn to apply critical reading skills in the foreign language, such as reading for comprehension and drawing conclusions. Communication strategies will also be used.

Specific Course Objectives:

- 1. Writing presentations and organizing lessons in Turkish.
- 2. Working with advanced vocabulary by using guessing, inferring meaning from context, and recognizing prefixes and suffixes.
- 3. Expanding vocabulary by using definitions and applying words in sentences.

Expected Learning Outcomes:

- 1. Functional mastery of the Turkish language at the B2 level.
- 2. Students will be able to understand and use Turkish in various academic and everyday situations, demonstrating advanced skills in comprehension, speaking, reading, and writing.
