COURSE SUMMARY AND LEARNING OUTCOMES:

General Learning Objectives: Expansion of Historical Knowledge: To equip students with deep knowledge of the political, social, and economic development of the United Kingdom. Encouragement of Engagement and Critical Thinking: To foster active participation in seminars and to encourage comparison of British historical events with those of Albania.
