SUMMARY AND LEARNING OUTCOMES:

General objectives:

- Deepening the knowledge of students about international organizations in the synchronous and diachronic axis.
- Familiarity with specific knowledge of the dynamics of international society, the function, role and activity of international institutions at the international, state and individual level.
- Combining the non-linguistic knowledge of the field of international (European) bodies with that of their profession translators and interpreters and education as citizens.
- Direct acquaintance with the terminology of the field and with the main actors of interstate relations - international intergovernmental organizations and international non-governmental organizations, cross-border crime, etc.

Specific subject objectives:

- Develop ability to process materials related to thematic and linguistic aspects of the field of international relations.
- Developability to be a genuine actor of the international community.
- Developability to choose scientific research topics that can provoke debate and be in the public interest.

Expected results:

Students should have acquired basic and in-depth knowledge, thematic and linguistic, on the international system, actors, international governmental and non-governmental organizations as well as the communication process, both within organizations and relations with structures outside them.
