COURSE DESCRIPTION AND LEARNING OUTCOMES:

General Course Objectives: The course English as a Second Language aims to provide students with a solid linguistic and communicative foundation for using English in everyday situations. Its main goal is to develop basic competence in the four language skills: listening, reading, speaking, and writing.

Specific Course Objectives: By the end of the course, students will be able to:

1. Communicate clearly and intelligibly in common everyday situations.
2. Apply basic rules of English grammar in both spoken and written communication.
3. Use English to read and write simple texts such as letters, messages, descriptions, and short narratives.

Expected Learning Outcomes: At the end of the course, students are expected to be able to:

1. Ask and answer questions in English on a variety of everyday topics with accuracy and fluency.
2. Engage in simple dialogues and communicate with other English speakers without major comprehension difficulties.
3. Participate in discussions on selected topics, expressing their opinions clearly.
4. Use basic English concepts in both formal and informal documents (letters, emails, notes, stories).
