COURSE SUMMARY AND LEARNING OUTCOMES:

General Course Objectives: To develop students' basic language competencies in English: speaking, listening, writing, and reading. To improve the ability to communicate clearly and fluently in English in everyday and academic situations. To encourage learner autonomy and vocabulary enrichment through interactive activities and authentic texts.

Specific Course Objectives:

1. To strengthen skills in reading and analyzing various texts (letters, advertisements, articles, literary excerpts, brochures, etc.).
2. To develop writing skills for different formats (application letters, reports, articles, short stories, descriptions, etc.).
3. To improve listening and speaking skills in real-life contexts: news, conversations, drama, advertisements, etc., as well as to stimulate vocabulary acquisition and self-correction.

Expected Learning Outcomes: By the end of the course, students will be able to:

1. Read and comprehend various texts, identifying main ideas, structure, and specific information.
2. Communicate clearly and accurately with native speakers in everyday life situations and discussions.
3. Write different types of texts with logical organization, correct spelling, and appropriate use of grammar and punctuation, as well as express opinions and arguments both orally and in writing on specific topics.
