COURSE DESCRIPTION AND LEARNING OUTCOMES:

General Course Objectives: The course aims to develop the students’ basic language competencies in English: speaking, listening, writing, and reading. It seeks to improve students’ ability to communicate clearly and fluently in English in both everyday and academic situations. The course encourages learner autonomy and vocabulary enrichment through interactive activities and authentic texts.

Specific Course Objectives:

- 1.To strengthen the ability to read and analyze various types of texts (letters, advertisements, articles, literary excerpts, brochures, etc.).
- 2.To develop writing skills in different formats (application letters, reports, articles, short stories, descriptions, etc.).
- 3.To improve listening and speaking skills in real-life contexts: news, conversations, drama, commercials, etc., and to promote vocabulary acquisition and self-correction.

Expected Learning Outcomes: By the end of the course, students will be able to:

- 1.Read and comprehend a variety of texts, identifying main ideas, structure, and specific information.
- 2.Communicate clearly and accurately with native speakers in everyday situations and in discussions.
- 3.Write various types of texts with logical organization, correct spelling, and proper use of grammar and punctuation, and express opinions and arguments both orally and in writing on selected topics.
