COURSE SUMMARY AND LEARNING OUTCOMES:

General Learning Objectives: To provide students with basic knowledge of the main lexicological phenomena in the English language. To develop their ability to use lexical units accurately and functionally. To educate students about the importance of auxiliary resources such as dictionaries and linguistic texts in the learning process.

Specific Learning Objectives:
