COURSE SUMMARY AND LEARNING OUTCOMES:

General Learning Objectives:

This course aims to equip students with theoretical and practical knowledge regarding the concept of the word and its morphological structure, enabling both morphemic and word-formation analysis. Through this course, students gain understanding of the parts of speech, their classification according to various criteria—form, meaning, function, origin, and structure—as well as lexico-grammatical categories, their paradigms, and the main word-formation processes in the Albanian language.

Specific Learning Objectives:

Students develop the ability to distinguish the various parts of speech and their corresponding lexico-grammatical categories and analyze them accordingly.

Students are also introduced to the word-formation models of the Albanian language, enabling them to carry out morphemic and word-formation analysis, and to enrich the language by forming new words based on its internal resources, following active and productive morphological patterns.
