COURSE SUMMARY AND LEARNING OUTCOMES

General Course Objectives: The student should be able to: Write and read accurately in Hebrew (with word vocalization); Understand the main grammatical rules of the Hebrew language; Learn basic vocabulary from various areas of everyday life; Understand and create simple texts and participate in basic dialogues.

Specific Course Objectives:

1. The student should acquire knowledge in the field of grammar.
2. The student is expected to have aptitude for learning foreign languages.

Expected Learning Outcomes:

By the end of this level, the student should be able to:

- Read and write Hebrew texts accurately and without difficulty, including texts with diacritical marks (nikkud).

- Develop communication skills for practical situations such as traveling, shopping at the market, visiting the doctor, etc.
- Describe time, days of the week, months, seasons of the year, colors, etc.
- Recognize and understand Hebrew numerals in both written and auditory forms.
- Formulate basic questions related to all the above-mentioned topics.
