COURSE SUMMARY AND LEARNING OUTCOMES

General Course Objectives: The internship program aims to provide students with: Broadened knowledge of cultural, historical, economic, and social issues related to the geographic areas corresponding to the selected languages, as well as foundational disciplines in the social, economic, and legal sciences. Expanded understanding of the role of the intercultural mediator in institutions involved in cultural relations between countries and peoples. Deeper insight into the role of the intercultural mediator in international organizations and associations, both foreign and domestic, as an operator and curator of international relations.

Specific Course Objectives:

1. **Linguistic competence:** The ability to communicate both orally and in writing, including knowledge of basic terminology in cultural and touristic communication.
2. **Digital competence:** The ability to search, manage, and reference information using the internet.
