SUMMARY AND LEARNING OUTCOMES:

At A1 level, the course provides an introduction to Albanian Sign Language and visual communication. It aims for students to acquire strategies for using Albanian Sign Language effectively. Students are encouraged to use learning materials and sign language dictionaries. The student is expected to develop their skills in sign language and achieve A1 proficiency in Albanian Sign Language. They demonstrate comprehension of familiar topics of conversation and become aware of the situation of deaf people in Albania. Students are enabled to communicate in Albanian Sign Language in everyday situations and to explore the culture of Deaf communities. The student achieves A1-level linguistic competence in Albanian Sign Language in Albania.
