SUMMARY AND LEARNING OUTCOMES:

At this level, familiar topics are developed alongside a structured and productive vocabulary, focusing on basic signs, verbal and descriptive expressions of time, and different ways of expressing everyday life situations, with greater emphasis on the linguistic aspects of sign language. Students work with various practical and similar texts and analyze them. They develop their sign language skills by practicing written sign language notation, which further supports and strengthens their linguistic competence in sign language. Students also explore variations in Albanian Sign Language and practice using signs in pair work and small group activities.

FUNDAMENTAL CONCEPTS:

1. Working with signs from the ANAD vocabulary
2. Production and comprehension of signs
3. Simple, everyday life situations
4. Spatial orientation and location
