SUMMARY AND LEARNING OUTCOMES

At B1 level, the student improves and deepens their knowledge of the structure of Albanian Sign Language and its use. This unit focuses on expanding students' sign language vocabulary and strengthening their comprehension and production skills. Students are expected to achieve B1 proficiency in Albanian Sign Language.

Students practice producing signed texts on various social topics. They develop their skills in using Albanian Sign Language in natural and social environments such as school, work, family, and everyday life. They engage in discussions with different Deaf communities and sign language groups and become more aware of their own communicative competence in sign language.

Students are able to use and explain the purpose of descriptive signs and distinguish them from gestures, providing short, spontaneous descriptions and narratives of different types. They are also trained to use different productive variations of sign language.
