SUMMARY AND LEARNING OUTCOMES

General course objectives:

The Applied Grammar course is designed with a mainly practical approach. The moderate use of French grammatical rules, through various grammar exercises, enables students to become familiar with these rules as well as with the difficulties of a language that may appear full of exceptions. The course includes exercises and texts organized according to the thematic units defined in the syllabus. For each grammatical topic covered in the program, activities and exercises adapted to the students' language levels are provided.

Specific course objectives:

The student is expected:

- To acquire basic knowledge of the course and to reinforce and deepen grammatical rules at A1, A2, and B1 levels
- To correctly identify and use articles
- To apply the rules for forming gender and number of nouns
- To recognize and properly use adjectives, adverbs, and prepositions in sentences
