SUMMARY AND LEARNING OUTCOMES

General course objectives:

This course aims to introduce students to international institutions in a synchronic perspective. Students are provided with basic knowledge of the function, role, and activities of international institutions at the international, state, and individual levels. The course also aims to integrate French language skills with thematic and extra-linguistic knowledge in the field of international institutions.

Specific course objectives:

In addition to providing linguistic and field-specific knowledge in international relations, offering an overview of the behavior of public and private actors, another objective is to develop the ability to think critically within the context of the development of international society through institutions. Students will learn how to use extra-linguistic knowledge in relation to their future profession, which is centered on foreign languages, and how to process texts using technical terminology.

Expected learning outcomes:

- Development of the ability to process materials related to the linguistic aspects of international relations terminology
- Development of analytical, critical, logical, and creative thinking skills by producing reasoned arguments on issues of international and local society
- Development of the ability to select and correctly reference academic and scientific bibliographic sources
- Development of the ability to pursue further studies and engage in autonomous academic work
