SUMMARY AND LEARNING OUTCOMES

General Course Objectives:

This practical module will provide first-year students with the opportunity to acquire and improve linguistic and lexical competences, as well as reading comprehension and written expression skills through lexical, grammatical, and cultural analysis. Student reflection on written language practices will be encouraged through a pedagogical approach based on observation, analysis, interaction, and the development of learner autonomy with regard to linguistic and orthographic aspects. Alongside the acquisition of skills for processing written materials and communicating in writing, the course also aims to develop students' intercultural competence through the study of authentic documents and activities that promote reflection and openness to other cultures.

Specific Course Objectives:

- To deepen and improve essential knowledge of French language structures at the lexical, syntactic, and grammatical levels;
- To develop observation and analytical skills, as well as a range of learning strategies that progressively lead to language autonomy;
- To develop written expression skills by selecting and using appropriate basic expressions and structures in order to argue, explain, and justify opinions and wishes.

Expected Learning Outcomes:

- To strengthen and improve knowledge of fundamental language structures in order to deepen basic grammatical, semantic, and orthographic competence.
- To understand a written text.
- To develop a plan for written expression.
- To enrich vocabulary and communicate in writing.
- To analyze and form a personal, reasoned, and active judgment on different sources and consulted literature.
