**THE ADMISSION CRITERIA FOR SECOND-CYCLE STUDENTS AT THE FACULTY
OF FOREIGN LANGUAGES, UNIVERSITY OF TIRANA, FOR THE ACADEMIC
YEAR 2026-2027.**

- I. Candidates, who are eligible to apply for registration in the second cycle of studies,
Master of Science in:

Teaching, Foreign Language, English Language

Teaching, Foreign Language, French Language

Teaching, Foreign Language, German Language

Teaching, Foreign Language, Italian Language

Teaching, Foreign Language, Greek Language

Teaching, Foreign Language, Turkish Language

1. Hold a diploma in the first-cycle study program, in the relevant language, at the Faculty of Foreign Languages and/or in other first-cycle programs, in the relevant language, at accredited public or private universities, domestic or foreign.
2. The admission criteria for the Master of Science programs in Teaching in Greek for Secondary Education and Teaching in Turkish for Secondary Education require candidates to have knowledge of one of the five official foreign languages of the European Union (English, French, German, Italian, Spanish), proven through internationally recognized language tests, in accordance with the relevant guideline of the minister responsible for education.

Note: Based on Guideline no. 10, dated 16.06.2023, "On an amendment to Guideline no. 52, dated 3.12.2015, 'On the determination of foreign language levels and international tests, for admissions to second and third cycle study programs in higher education institutions,' the candidate must have knowledge of the foreign language at least **at level B1**.

Note: The ranking of successful candidates will be done in descending order of their average grade until the approved quotas are filled.



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II. Eligible to apply for registration in the second cycle of studies, **MASTER OF SCIENCE IN: TRILINGUAL INTERCULTURAL COMMUNICATION AND TOURISM** are:

1. Candidates who hold a diploma in a first-cycle study program, at the Faculty of Foreign Languages and/or in similar first-cycle programs, at accredited public or private universities, domestic or foreign.
2. The admission criterion for this Master's program is the candidate's proficiency in one of the five official foreign languages of the European Union (English, French, German, Italian, Spanish), proven through internationally recognized language tests, in accordance with the relevant guideline of the minister responsible for education. If the individual has obtained a diploma from a study program conducted in one of these languages, the obtained diploma will serve as proof for meeting this criterion.

Note: The ranking of successful candidates will be done in descending order of their average grade until the approved quotas are filled.

III. Eligible to apply for registration in the second cycle of studies, **MASTER OF SCIENCE IN TECHNICAL-LITERARY TRANSLATION AND INTERPRETING** are:

1. Candidates who hold a diploma in a first-cycle study program, at the Faculty of Foreign Languages and/or in similar first-cycle programs, at accredited public or private universities, domestic or foreign.
2. The admission criterion for the “*Master of Science*” program is the candidate's proficiency in one of the five official foreign languages of the European Union (English, French, German, Italian, Spanish), proven through internationally recognized language tests, in accordance with the relevant guideline of the minister responsible for education. If the individual has obtained a diploma from a study program conducted in one of these languages, the obtained diploma will serve as proof for meeting this criterion.

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IV. Eligible to apply for registration in the second cycle of studies, **PROFESSIONAL MASTER'S PROGRAMME IN PRAGMATIC TRANSLATION WITH A SPECIALIZATION IN SPECIALIZED TRANSLATION** ARE:

1. Candidates who have completed a first-cycle study program at an accredited university, either within the country or abroad, and recognized by the Ministry of Education,
2. The admission criterion for this study program "*Master of Science*" is the candidate's proficiency in one of the five official foreign languages of the European Union (English, French, German, Italian, Spanish), proven through internationally recognized language tests, in accordance with the relevant guideline of the minister responsible for education. If the individual has obtained a diploma from a study program conducted in one of these languages, the obtained diploma will serve as proof for meeting this criterion.

Note: Based on Guideline no. 10, dated 16.06.2023, "On an amendment to Guideline no. 52, dated 3.12.2015, 'On the determination of foreign language levels and international tests, for admissions to second and third cycle study programs in higher education institutions,' the candidate must have knowledge of the foreign language at least at **level B1**.

V. Eligible to apply for registration in the second cycle of studies, **MASTER OF SCIENCE IN "NATURAL LANGUAGE PROCESSING OF WRITTEN DOCUMENTS"** are:

- a) Candidates who hold a diploma in a first-cycle study program from accredited public or private universities, domestic or foreign.
- b) The admission criterion for this study program "*Master of Science*" is the candidate's proficiency in both French and English, proven through internationally recognized language tests, in accordance with the relevant guideline of the minister responsible for education. If the individual has obtained a diploma from a study program conducted in one of these languages, the obtained diploma will serve as proof for meeting this criterion.
